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Thrips primary cells

Hi Ralf,

Amalendu's thrips primary cells (labelled: Ralf's thrips EC 06/12/2016 EC = embryonic cells) are stored at QAAFI's LN2 tank, Tower #84, box #2 (mitter's group).

Those cells (I check under microscopy before removed them from culture flask, and found that there were not many cells) were removed and centrifuged at 300 x g for 15 mins at 4C, and then resuspended with 0.5 ml FCS+10% DMSO, and then -1C/minute to -80C.

The supernatant were placed back to the flask (in case that there were still some cells in the flask/supernatant). I shall keep eye on those cells and hope that there may be more cells in the near future.
